

Self-isolation Guidance for Parents/Carers/Visitors

What if	Action	Return to school
My child has Covid-19 Symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school and inform us • Self-isolate entire household • Book a test • Inform the school immediately of a test result 	⇒ When the test comes back negative or 14 days have passed since the symptoms started
My child tests POSITIVE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school and inform us • Self-isolate entire household 	⇒ Consult current public guidance
My child tests NEGATIVE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact school to inform us • Discuss when your child can come back (same day/next day) 	⇒ The test comes back NEGATIVE
My child is ill with symptoms not linked to Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact the school to inform us • Ring each day of illness 	⇒ After 48 hours following the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea
Someone in my household has Covid-19 symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school to inform us • Self-isolate entire household • Book a test • Inform the school immediately of the test result 	⇒ The test comes back NEGATIVE or 14 days self-isolation (whichever is soonest)
Someone in my household tests POSITIVE for Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school to inform us • Self-isolate entire household • Refer to Principal 	⇒ Consult current public guidance
NHS Test and Trace has identified my child as a close contact of someone with symptoms or confirmed case	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school to inform us 	⇒ Child has completed 14 days self-isolation
NHS Test and Trace has identified a household member as a close contact of someone with symptoms or confirmed case	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The household member must self-isolate for 14 days • Child is able to come to school UNLESS that household member starts showing symptoms 	⇒ Child can continue at school UNLESS household member starts showing symptoms. If household member shows symptoms whole household must self-isolate for 14 days
A sibling attending another school/college has been sent home to self-isolate due to a POSITIVE case in their school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sibling must self-isolate for 14 days • Child is able to attend school 	⇒ Child can continue at school UNLESS sibling starts showing symptoms. If sibling shows symptoms whole household must self-isolate for 14 days
My child has travelled abroad from a country or territory that is NOT on the exempt list of countries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If returning from a destination where quarantine is needed: ⇒ Minimum of 14 days self-isolation for all those who travelled ⇒ Contact school to inform us you have returned 	⇒ Child has completed 14 days self-isolation
